Essential Functions:

- Install, service and repair parking access and revenue control systems throughout Central and Southwestern, VA. Systems include access control, vehicle detection systems, swing, slide and barrier gate operators, ticket

dispensers, fee computers and information networks. Service a wide range of gate operator and vehicle control equipment. Most equipment is CPU-based while some is electromechanical. 50% of time will be spent on servicing existing systems. Interface directly with the customer while onsite to complete repairs.

- Based out of Richmond office, work outdoors, at construction sites, parking decks and office environments depending on day-today needs. Apply experience and training in installation, correction of failures and customer-requested modifications.
- Conduct periodic after-hours and weekend work (overtime paid at 1.5 times base pay). Overnight travel occasionally required to customer sites throughout southern Virginia. Serve in an on-call status for emergency service calls during weekends and after hours every six weeks (\$75/week bonus paid while in this status in addition to actual hours worked).
- Interact with customers of varying levels of sophistication, addressing all concerns.
- Supervision. Will report to Entry Guard Systems President.

Other Requirements:
