IPMI's annual Awards and Recognition programs celebrate individuals and organizations in the parking, transportation, and mobility industry. Winners in three major award categories—Awards of Excellence, Professional Recognition Awards, and Marketing Awards—exemplify industry excellence.



Professional Recognition Awards

Professional Recognition Awards recognize the individual contributions of parking, transportation, and mobility industry professionals—our industry's best. Entrants for these prestigious awards may be self- or peer-nominated. Nominees must be IPMI members in good standing and there is no nomination fee. Categories include:

- NEW! Professional Excellence Awards.
- Emerging Leader of the Year.
- Organization of the Year.
- James M. Hunnicutt, CAPP, Industry Professional of the Year.

What's New in 2020

- The Parking Professional of the Year is now Industry Professional of the Year! Our industry is changing (just like our name) and this is no exception. Candidates will be considered from parking, transportation, and mobility professionals.
- NEW CATEGORY! Professional Excellence Awards recognizes excellence for all staff, from the front-line to management. Awards will recognize outstanding performance in a variety of areas. For this category, submitters **identify and select** an area of excellence. IPMI will choose a few stellar individuals and will not necessarily award in all suggested or submitted areas. Suggested categories include, but are not limited to:
 - Customer Service
 - Management
 - Finance
 - Operations
 - Marketing
 - Leadership
 - Innovation

Entry Requirements & Criteria

Entry requirements vary by category and are provided in detail below.

PROFESSIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARDS (NEW!)

Professional Excellence Awards recognizes excellence for all staff, from the front-line to management. Awards will recognize outstanding performance in a variety of areas.

- Contact information of submitter and nominated individual
- Suggested Excellence Category
- Narrative introducing the individual and why they are deserving of recognition (minimum 500 words; maximum 1,000 words) as a Word document.
- Resume, job description, or outline of duties, in pdf format.
- Letter of recommendation from a supervisor in pdf format.
- Letter of recommendation from a peer or subordinate in pdf format.
- Additional supporting documentation, if desired, in pdf format.
- Photography: Submit a minimum of one professional headshot (high resolution, 300 dpi). Up to three additional relevant high-resolution images of the professional may also be submitted to showcase the individual.
- Videos may also be submitted, if desired, via a YouTube link.

Nominations should exhibit excellence in the suggested category, in addition to the following:

- Contribution(s) to the parking, transportation, and mobility industry.
- Professional reputation.
- Creative solutions or innovations.
- Breadth of program and service.
- IPMI member in good standing.

EMERGING LEADER OF THE YEAR

This award recognizes an up-and-coming young professional who has exhibited outstanding leadership and accomplishments in their career. IPMI honors an emerging leader each year to promote and recognize the best and brightest young professionals in the industry.

- Contact information of submitter and nominated individual.
- Narrative introducing the individual and why they are deserving of recognition (minimum 500 words; maximum 1,000 words), as a Word document. Include a description of professional achievements, advancement of creative innovations or ideas, and exceptional leadership in the industry.
- Resume, job description, or outline of duties, including a bulleted list of the nominee's extraordinary accomplishments, in pdf format.
- Letter of recommendation from a supervisor, member of the organization's management team, or from a peer, in pdf format.
- Additional supporting documentation, if desired, in pdf format.
- Photography: Submit a minimum of one professional headshot (high resolution, 300 dpi). Up to three additional relevant high-resolution images of the professional may also be submitted to showcase the individual. Videos may also be submitted, if desired, via a YouTube link.
- Copy of the individual's valid driver's license, passport, or other government-issued photo identification demonstrating the nominee is 40 years of age or younger as of December 31, 2019.

Nomination materials should exhibit the following:

- Serve in a parking, transportation, and/or mobility position at the time of the nomination and has worked for a minimum of two years in the industry, demonstrating exceptional leadership.
- Commitment to advancing unique and innovative ideas.
- Professional character and reputation.
- A record of service and leadership of IPMI and/or its affiliates.
- Indications of service and leadership include participation on boards, committees, task forces, publications, and presentations, etc.
- Community service including civic organizations and agencies outside the industry.
- Service to the profession above and beyond normal job responsibilities.
- Service to educational organizations and agencies other than IPMI as well as other contributions to the profession.
- IPMI member in good standing.
- Age 40 or younger (as of December 31, 2019)

ORGANIZATION OF THE YEAR

This award recognizes an organization that demonstrates comprehensive operational excellence across a wide range of areas, including organizational culture, customer service, innovation, and more.

Nominations to include:

- Contact information of submitter and nominated organization
- Narrative introducing the organization and why it is deserving of recognition (minimum 1,000 words; maximum 2,000 words), in Word format.
 - o This narrative should include a comprehensive list of programs and services provided by the organization, as well as statistics and figures that describe the volume, size, efficiency, service, etc. of the organization.
 - o Include a brief description highlighting a specific cutting-edge program or service that the organization has implemented in the last two years. Discuss the outcome of this new program or service and how it affected the organization and/or its customers.
- Organizational chart in pdf format.
- Operating statement in pdf format.
- Brochures, annual reports, or related supporting materials in pdf format.
- Overview of the organization from the appropriate manager or director.
- Letter of recommendation from another organization.
- Customer satisfaction survey data, if available and/or appropriate.
- Graphics & Visuals:
 - o Organization's logo in high-quality format (300 dpi min.).
 - o A minimum of four and a maximum of six photographs (high-resolution, 300 dpi min.) showcasing the organization, its staff, and its work. Videos may also be submitted, if desired, via a YouTube link.

Nomination materials should exhibit the following:

- Contribution to the parking, transportation, and mobility industry.
- Commitment to advancing unique and innovative ideas and creativity.
- Breadth of programs and services.
- Demonstration of standards of excellence in customer service, operations, finance, human resources, professional development, marketing, and more.
- IPMI member in good standing.

JAMES M. HUNNICUTT, CAPP, INDUSTRY PROFESSIONAL OF THE YEAR

This award recognizes a professional who has exhibited outstanding leadership and accomplishments in their career.

Nominations to include:

- Contact information of submitter and nominated individual.
- Narrative introducing the individual and why they are deserving of recognition (minimum 500 words; maximum 1,000 words), in Word format. Include a description of professional achievements, advancement of creative innovations or ideas, and exceptional leadership in the industry.
- Resume, job description, or outline of duties, including a bulleted list of the nominee's extraordinary accomplishments, in pdf format.
- Letter of recommendation from a supervisor or member of the organization's management team in pdf format.
- Letter of recommendation from a peer or subordinate in pdf format.
- Additional supporting documentation, if desired, in pdf format.
- Photography: Submit a minimum of one professional headshot (high resolution, 300 dpi). Up to three additional relevant high-resolution images of the professional may also be submitted to showcase the individual.
- Videos may also be submitted, if desired, via a YouTube link.

Nomination materials should exhibit the following:

- Serve in a parking, transportation, and/or mobility position at the time of the nomination.
- Contribution(s) to the parking, transportation, and mobility industry.
- Commitment to advancing unique and innovative ideas.
- Professional character and reputation.

- Indications of service and leadership include participation on boards, committees, task forces, publications, and presentations, etc.
- Community service including civic organizations and agencies outside the industry.
- Service to the profession above and beyond normal job responsibilities.
- Service to educational organizations and agencies other than IPMI as well as other contributions to the profession.
- IPMI member in good standing.
